

**PHOTOGRAPHY AND IMAGING: Major Requirements  
For Transfer Students entering Fall 2005 and later**

**AREA I: STUDIO/PRODUCTION COURSES** **40 credits (minimum)**

*Required Studio Courses:*

Color Theory and Printing	4 pts
Imaging for Transfers or Photography & Imaging III	4 pts
Senior Directed Projects (fall of senior year)	4 pts

Additional studio courses to bring cumulative points to a minimum of 40

**AREA II: CRITICAL STUDIES** **24 credits (minimum)**

*Required Critical Studies Courses:*

Culture, History, Imaging & Photography Studies (CHIPS)	4 pts
Course optional but recommended for transfer students	
Social History of Photography (fall)	4 pts
Aesthetic History of Photography (spring)	4 pts
These two courses are pre-requisites for other Critical Studies courses	
1 Critical Studies Course (junior/senior year)	4 pts
1 Advanced History Seminar (junior/senior year)	4 pts

Additional Critical Studies course(s) to bring the total to 24

**AREA III: LIBERAL ARTS COURSES** **44 credits (minimum)**

*Required Liberal Arts Courses (minimums for each area):*

Expository Writing: Art and the World/The World Through Art (fall/spring) 4 pts  
*If you do not transfer in a minimum of 3 points (one course) in Expository Writing*

Language and Literature: 1 Literature OR 2 semesters of one language 4-8 pts

Humanities: History of Western Art II. 4 pts  
*A second Art History course is HIGHLY recommended*

Social Science: 1 course 4 pts  
*(i.e., Anthropology, Economics, Politics, Psychology, Sociology)*

Natural Science/Mathematics: 1 course 4 pts  
*(i.e., Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Math, Computer Science)*

Additional Liberal Arts from any of the above areas to bring cumulative points to a minimum of 44.

**AREA IV: ELECTIVES\*** **20 credits**

Elective credit will often include credit transferred from transfers' prior institution.

\* An elective can be any course, in any subject, in any division of New York University **except** the School of Continuing and Professional Studies. Any course in the major that a student does not receive a C or better counts as elective credit and does not count towards the Photography & Imaging major.

**Credits bring cumulative total to total Credits Required for BFA: 128 credits**
